The Court : The petitioner is aggrieved that in spite of tendering the entire amount, the bank has not handed over possession of the property.

The further grievance and far more serious one is that the bank confirmed the sale in favour of the petitioner in the teeth of a subsisting order by the Debts Recovery Tribunal dated January 27, 2025 not to confirm the sale.

Affidavit of service, as filed, is taken on record.

In spite of service none appears for the Punjab National Bank. Ms. Roy Chowdhury, who usually appears for the said bank is present in court and is requested to take up the matter. A copy of the petition has been served on her in court today. Ms. Roy Chowdhury is requested to take appropriate instructions in the matter by the returnable date.
