The Court: This is an application for amendment of the plaint.

The plaintiff says that the name of the defendant was typed as "Rakesh Singh" instead of "Rakesh Kumar" and as such the writ of summons could not also be served on the defendant. There is only one defendant in the suit but in the concise statement and some other portions of the plaint it appears to be the defendants. The amendment sought for are shown in red ink in annexure "C" to this application and are formal in nature and is as such allowed. The word 'defendants' in the concise statement and other portions of the plaint shall be treated as 'defendant' and may be corrected at the time of scrutiny.

In the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the amendment as indicated in red ink in a copy of the plaint annexed hereto and marked as Annexure-"C" be

carried out within a period of fortnight from the date of communication of this order.

The parties shall co-operate with the Department for carrying out the amendment. Once the amendment is carried out the plaintiff will have the liberty to re-affirm and re-verify the plaint. After re-verification and re-affirmation, a legible copy of the amended plaint with all annexures shall be served on the defendant.

Nothing further remains to be adjudicated in this application.

The application being IA No. GA/1/2026 in CS/11/2026 is, accordingly, disposed of.
