1. The alleged contemnor no.1 Md. Rizwan is present in terms of the Rule issued by this Court and he was examined and he submits that due to the financial crisis, he could not pay the amount as directed by this Court by order dated 25th September, 2024. Accordingly, he submits that by 9th or 10th June, 2026 he will pay the amount as directed by this Court.
2. The alleged contemnor no.2 Md. Imran is present in terms of the Rule issued by this Court and he was examined and he submits that due to the financial crisis, he could not pay the amount as directed by this Court by order dated 25th September, 2024. Accordingly, he submits that

by 9th or 10th June, 2026 he will pay his share of the amount as directed by this Court.

3. The alleged contemnor no.3 Md. Arif is present in terms of the Rule issued by this Court and he was examined and he submits that due to the financial crisis, he could not pay the amount as directed by this Court by order dated 25th September, 2024. Accordingly, he submits that by 9th or 10th June, 2026 he will pay the amount as directed by this Court.
4. The alleged contemnor no.4, Md. Tarique is present in terms of the Rule issued by this Court and he was examined and he submits that due to the financial crisis, he could not pay the amount as directed by this Court by order dated 25th September, 2024. Accordingly, he submits that by 9th or 10th June, 2026 he will pay the amount as directed by this Court.
5. The alleged contemnor no.5, Md. Sadique is present in terms of the rule issued by this Court and he was examined and he submits that due to the financial crisis, he could not pay the amount as directed by this Court by order dated 25th September, 2024. Accordingly, he submits that by 9th or 10th June, 2026 he will pay the amount as directed by this Court of his chair.
6. The alleged contemnor no.6, Maleka Khatoon is present in terms of the Rule issued by this Court and he was examined and she submits that due to the financial crisis, she could not pay the amount as directed by this Court by order dated 25th September, 2024. Accordingly, he submits

that by 9th or 10th June, 2026 she will pay the amount as directed by this Court.

7. As per the report submitted by the Deputy Sheriff of Calcutta dated 9th March, 2026, Rule was served only against the alleged contemnor nos.1 to 3 and the Rule could not be served upon the alleged contemnor nos.4 to 6 but when the matter is called, all the contemnors are present. They have been examined before this Court and they submit that they will pay the amount in terms of the order dated 25th September, 2024 by 9th/10th of June, 2026.
8. As per the undertaking given by the alleged contemnors on oath, the case is adjourned.
9. Let the matter appear on 11th June, 2026 and the contemnors are directed to deposit their respective shares as per the order dated 25th September, 2024 before the Registrar Original Side, High Court Calcutta, on or before 9th/10th June, 2026 and to place the documents before this Court with regard to the deposit of the amount and to appear in person on the date fixed.
10. The Registrar, Original Side is directed to submit the report before this Court on 11th June, 2026 whether any of the contemnors have deposited any amount in terms of the order dated 25th September, 2024.
11. List the matter on 11th June, 2026.
