1. The alleged contemnor Nos. 2 and 3 were brought under arrest.

2. The alleged contemnor Nos. 1, 2, 5 and 6 are surrender voluntarily before this Court, against the warrant of arrest issued against the contemnor Nos. 1, 2, 5 and 6.

3. Counsel for the alleged contemnor Nos. 1 to 6 prays for time to file affidavit in opposition.

4. The contemnor no. 13 has filed affidavit in opposition. Let the same be kept with the record.

5. The Counsel for the petitioner has filed affidavit in reply to the affidavit in opposition in connection with the affidavit in opposition of contemnor nos. 8, 9, 10, 11, 13 as well as 7 and 12. Let the same be kept with the record.

6. As the alleged contemnor Nos. 3 and 4 have been brought under arrest, and the alleged contemnor Nos. 1, 2, 5 and 6 have voluntarily surrendered before this Court, accordingly, they have been released on personal bond of Rs.10,000/- with one surety each with the direction to appear before this Court on each and every date of hearing and shall file comprehensive affidavit within 10 days that is on or before 10th November, 2025 by serving the copy to the learned Counsel for the petitioner. The petitioner is at liberty to file affidavit in reply if, any, thereto within a week thereafter.

7. List the matter on 28th November, 2025.

8. As the alleged contemnor Nos. 3 and 4 have been brought under arrest and the other alleged contemnor nos. 1, 2, 5 and 6 have surrendered, accordingly, the warrant may be kept in abeyance.
