The Court : The learned Advocate representing the decree holder submitted that the affidavit of assets filed on behalf of the judgment debtor had been inconclusive in terms of certain forms to have not been complied with regard to the information as far as bank accounts, shares and stocks and other properties etc. are concerned.

Learned Advocate representing the judgment debtor submitted that the next date to have been fixed by the Appellate Court had been 19th January, 2026. It was further submitted by the learned Advocate representing the judgment debtor that the decretal sum of Rs.3 crores and odd had already been secured to the tune of Rs.3 crores and odd.

Next date be fixed on 29th January, 2026 for further orders.

In case the order passed by the Appellate Court is not to the favour of the judgment debtor, he is to furnish the details with regard to the bank accounts, shares and stocks and other properties etc. which have not been earlier stated in the affidavit of assets.

It was further submitted that a sum of Rs.1 crore had been paid to the decree holder in compliance with the order of the Division Bench dated 16th December, 2025.
