1. THE COURT: Affidavit of service filed by the petitioner is taken on record.
2. In spite of service of notice, respondents nos.1, 2, 3 and 4 are not represented.
Matter is heard in presence of the learned Advocates representing the petitioner and the respondents nos.5 and 6.
3. Grievance of the petitioner is debit freezing of its bank account lying in Karur Vysya Bank, N.S. Road Branch, Kolkata. Placing reliance on a document at page 31 of the writ petition, it is submitted by learned Advocate representing the petitioner that particulars of the account are not tallying with the particulars disclosed therein.
4. Learned Advocate representing the respondent no.6 has submitted that on receipt of notice dated November 29, 2025 from the investigating agency, bank account

of the petitioner was debit frozen. However, it is not disclosed on behalf of respondent no.6 the transaction linking the account of the petitioner and layer of transaction.

5. Learned Advocate representing the respondent no.6 has prayed for accommodation to ascertain particulars of the alleged transaction linking the account of the petitioner.
6. Bank authority being the respondent no.6 is directed to take steps for disclosing the reasons behind debit freezing bank account of the petitioner by making communications with the investigating agency and a report to be filed on the next date.
7. List the matter under the same heading for further consideration on June 10, 2026.
