The Court: The petitioners have preferred the present arbitration petition filed under Section 11 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, seeking constitution of an Arbitral Tribunal for adjudication of the disputes arising out of and in connection with Clause 15.9 of the development agreement dated 16th August, 2012.

Learned Counsel for the respondent appears and states that he is ready for an amicable settlement of the present dispute and undertakes before this Court that he shall make the payment of the outstanding dues within a period of three months.

Learned Counsel for the Petitioner though does not oppose the stand taken by the respondent, he states that since the parties are exploring the possibility of an amicable settlement, let this matter be referred to the Mediation Centre at the Calcutta High Court.

In view thereof, the matter will be placed before the Mediation Centre at the Calcutta High Court. The Mediation Centre shall appoint a Senior Mediator to mediate the dispute between the parties.

Let this matter be listed after mediation before this Court on 14th July, 2026.
