Praying, inter alia, for a direction upon the municipal authorities to set aside the Memorandum dated 20th February, 2018 issued by the Special Municipal Commissioner, Kolkata Municipal Corporation whereby the Special Municipal Commissioner as a Disciplinary Authority had informed the petitioner that an inquiry will be held against him under Regulation 9 of the Kolkata Municipal Corporation (Classification, Control & Appeal) Regulations, 1985, the instant writ petition has been filed.
