The Court:- This is an execution application filed by the plaintiff to execute the decree dated **February 20, 2026**. The principal amount in the decree is **Rs.1,31,84,275.64**. Additionally, interest is also there. The defendant was directed to pay the amount within **four months** from the judgment and order dated **January 8, 2026** which had expired on or about **May 8, 2026**. The Master Summons has been taken out on **May 14, 2026**.

The judgment-debtor is not represented neither the decretal due has been paid off.

This Court has been informed by Mr. Anujit Mookherjee, learned Advocate appearing for the decree-holder that to their knowledge, no appeal has been carried out from the decree. Thus, it appears that the decree has crystallized.

In view of the above, the judgment-debtor is directed to secure the principal amount mentioned in the decree with the **Registrar**, Original Side of this Court, positively within a period of **six weeks** from date.

In the event such deposit is made, the **Registrar**, Original Side of this Court shall invest the same in an interest bearing fixed deposit account with any nationalized bank of his choice and shall prepare a report along with the fixed deposit receipt and keep the same in the original suit file.

The judgment-debtor shall also file an affidavit of assets within the said period of **six weeks** from date.

The decree-holder/applicant shall serve a copy of today's order upon the judgment-debtor and shall file an affidavit of service when the matter shall be taken up next.

The matter shall appear in the **Monthly List** of **August, 2026**, under the heading "**New Chamber Applications**".
