The Court: Upon going through the affidavit-of-service and envelopes which have been returned and have been placed before this Court, it would transpire that the service on the respondent nos. 5, 6 and 7 are incomplete. Let the original envelopes without their contents as placed before this Court be taken on record.

Though Mr. Basu, learned senior counsel representing the petitioners would submit that the service has been effected upon the respondent nos. 5, 6 and 7 at their recorded address, however, in view of the fact that the respondent no. 5 is a perpetual minor and noting from the endorsement made by the postal authorities that the address provided by the petitioners is insufficient, I direct the municipal authorities to disclose the recorded address of the respondent nos. 5, 6

and 7 as recorded in the books of the Kolkata Municipal Corporation on the returnable date.

List this matter for further consideration under the same heading on 27th November 2025.

This order will, however, not stand in the way of the petitioners to complete the service in the meantime.
