The Court: The plaint has been filed with this interlocutory application for injunction.

Today Mr. Chayan Gupta, learned Advocate appearing for the plaintiff moves this injunction application *ex parte* for securing his claim.

The inescapable facts are that on a land, admittedly situated at **Jharkhand**, beyond the territorial jurisdiction of this Court, the plaintiff has invested money. The understanding between the parties was the plaintiff and the defendants both will deal with the land in the manner, as agreed upon. For whatever reasons, the deal has failed. The plaintiff now claims its money back.

Considering the case made out in the injunction application, in the aid of the reliefs claimed in the plaint, this Court finds that the defendants must be on notice before this application is moved.

Plaintiff shall serve notice along with a copy of the injunction application upon the defendants and file an affidavit of service on the next day.

The matter shall appear under the heading “**New Motion**” on **July 17, 2026**.
