The Court:- Mr. Rupak Ghosh, learned Advocate (VC) with Mr. Sourath Nath Dutt, learned Advocate being ably assisted by Ms. Abhipiya Sarkar, learned Advocate appearing for the plaintiff submits after the order of injunction dated June 23, 2026 has been passed, the entire payment covering the LC amount has been received by the plaintiff. Therefore, the order of injunction may be vacated.

Mr. Nitish Samanta, learned Advocate appears for Standard Chartered Bank, though not impleaded in the suit.

Affidavit-of-service filed in Court today is taken on record.

None appears for the defendants, despite notice.

In view of the above, the order of injunction dated **June 23, 2026** stands **vacated**.

Mr. Rupak Ghosh, learned Advocate further submits that they have received instruction from their client to withdraw the suit and accordingly a communication has been made over to this Court dated July 16, 2026 which is taken on record.

The communication specifically says that the plaintiff is not interested to pursue the suit any further.

Be that as it may, the plaintiff shall be at liberty to file a short affidavit disclosing its stand with the above referred communication so that steps can be taken for withdrawal of this suit though the plaintiff contends that its claim on account of interest is still there.
