The Court : This is an application for dismissal of the rectification application. This application has been made by an entity who claims that the mark of which rectification has been sought for is assigned to the applicant. The applicant, therefore, ought to have been put on notice of the rectification application, if not made a party.

The petitioner in the rectification application, however, disputes the assignment and says that the assignment was allegedly made at a time when the company had already gone into liquidation.

This fact is again disputed by the applicant. The applicant also says that in a rectification application the assignment in favour of the applicant cannot be challenged.

The matter, therefore, requires to be heard on affidavits.

Let affidavit-in-opposition be filed by 14th August, 2026; reply thereto, if any, be filed by 2nd September, 2026. Matter to appear in the monthly list of September, 2026.

The applicant shall serve a copy of this application on the Official Liquidator, if not already served. The applicant will be also at liberty to seek for a copy of the rectification application from the petitioner in the rectification application being IPDATM 9 of 2026.
