The Court : This is an application by defendant no.1 in the suit. The said defendant no.1 invites the Court to expunge the name of Mr. Basab Roy Chowdhury, defendant no.2 who has been impleaded in the capacity of General Secretary of the West Bengal Medical and Sales Representatives Union being the defendant no.1. Since Mr. Chowdhury is no more the General Secretary, the said defendant no. 2, his name is required to be deleted/expunged as per defendant no. 1. However, the present Secretary, Mr. Suman Bhattacharya is already the defendant no.4 but not in the capacity of General Secretary of the defendant no. 1 and has not been described as the General Secretary in the cause title.

Mr. Kaushik Chakraborty, defendant no.3 is also no more the District Committee President and, as such, the defendant no.1 has prayed for expunging his name from the array of defendants.

It appears from the record that whenever there is an election in the defendant no.1 – Union, the General Secretary, the President and the office bearers are likely to change. This change is delaying the hearing of the matter.

The plaintiff seeks further extension of time to file an affidavit.

An extension of time to file affidavit was granted to the plaintiff by an order dated 9th June, 2026 but such affidavit has not been filed as yet.

In the facts and circumstances as aforesaid, let such affidavit be peremptorily filed by the plaintiff by 7th August, 2026; reply, if any, be filed by 21st August, 2026.

Matter to appear in the monthly list of September 2026.

It is made clear that if the affidavit is not filed by the plaintiff within the extended period of time, the matter will be heard without such affidavit.
