The Court: Affidavit of service filed today be kept with the records.

GA/1/2026 is an application for re-imposition of the interim order passed on August 5, 2024 which got extended from time to time.

Ms. Roychoudhury, learned Senior Advocate appearing for the petitioner, submits that the interim order subsisted till the end of December, 2025, however, due to inadvertence on the part of the learned Advocate-on-Record for

the petitioner, the same could not be mentioned for further extension and, as such, the interim order expired with the end of December, 2025.

Since the interim order has continued for a substantial period of time starting August 5, 2024 and there has been no change of circumstance in the interregnum, this Court is of the view that the said interim order should be reimposed and continued till the end of March, 2026.
