The Court: Ms. Pubali Sinha Chowdhury, learned counsel, is appearing for the petitioner.

The matter is listed as "To Be Mentioned" on the prayer made by the Counsel for the petitioner.

By an order dated 15th January, 2025, this court has allowed the petitioner to publish the notice in the English and Hindi daily newspaper, namely, "Indian Express" and in "Dainik Jagran" at Delhi as well as Madhya Pradesh.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that though the publication in English and Hindi daily newspaper "Indian Express" and "Dainik Jagran" are available in Delhi but no publication of "Indian Express" and "Dainik Jagran" are published at Madhya Pradesh.

Accordingly, the petitioner has published the notice at Madhya Pradesh in English newspaper namely, "The Pioneer", "Free Press" and Hindi newspaper "Navduniya".

Counsel for the petitioner submits that as this Court has allowed the petitioner to publish the notice in the "Indian Express" and "Dainik

Jagran” but in Madhya Pradesh, the said paper publication were not available. Accordingly, the petitioner has published the notice in the English newspaper, “The Pioneer”, “Free Press” and in the Hindi daily newspaper, “Navduniya”, but the department is not accepting the same and prays for a direction upon the department to accept the said publication.

In view of the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the department is directed to accept the affidavits affirmed by the petitioner enclosing the paper publication made in Delhi in the English daily newspaper “Indian Express”, in Hindi newspaper “Dainik Jagran” and in Madhya Pradesh in English newspaper namely, “The Pioneer”, “Free Press” and Hindi newspaper “Navduniya”.
