The Court: Upon reading the averments in the plaint and specifically at **paragraph 33** of the plaint, this Court finds that the plaintiff has contemplated an urgent interim relief. Accordingly, the requirement for pre-institution mediation under **Section 12A of The Commercial Courts Act, 2015**, stands dispensed with.

Reading the averments made in **paragraph 36** of the plaint, leave is granted under **Clause 12 of the Letters Patent, 1865**.

Considering the averments made in **paragraph 39** of the plaint, leave is granted under **Order II to Rule 2 of Code of Civil Procedure, 1908**.

The plaint stands **admitted**, subject to scrutiny by the department.
