The Court : Justice Alope Chakrabarti, former Judge of this Court who was initially appointed as the Special Officer and Mr. Surajit Nath Mitra, Senior Advocate, who was appointed as the Joint Special Officer at the invitation of the parties by an order dated 6th May, 2025 had expressed their disinclination to continue and / or act as the Joint Special Officers. The letters issued by Justice Alope Chakrabarti (Retd.) and Mr. Surojit Nath Mitra, Senior Advocate are respectively annexed at pages 167 and 168 of this application.

In this application the plaintiffs have sought for appointment of substitute Special Officers and/or Joint Special Officers in place and stead of Justice Alope Chakrabarti (Retd.) and Mr. Surojit Nath Mitra, Senior Advocate. The parties have agreed to the names of Justice Jyotirmay Bhattacharya, former Chief Justice of this Court and Mr. Samrat Sen, Senior Advocate as the Joint Special Officers.

Justice Jyotirmay Bhattacharya, former Chief Justice of this Court and Mr. Samrat Sen, Senior Advocate are at the invitation of the parties and on their consent appointed as Joint Special Officers in place and stead of Justice Alope Chakrabarti (Retd.) and Mr. Surojit Nath Mitra, Senior Advocate. The order dated 6th May, 2025 is modified to this extent. Since there has been a delay in commencing the work as directed by the said order dated 6th May, 2025, for the reasons as aforesaid, the time to conclude the sale is extended till 29th October, 2025. The other terms and conditions will remain the same as indicated in the order dated 6th May, 2025.

Let CSOS 5 of 2024 appear in the list on 10th November, 2025 when the Joint Special Officers shall file their report.

Nothing further remains to be adjudicated in this application.

The application being GA/5/2025 is, accordingly, disposed of.

Since I have not called for any affidavit, the allegations, if any, contained in the application are deemed to have not been admitted by the respondents.
