Affidavit of service filed in Court today is taken on record.

This is an application by 236 persons, who were directed to be added

as party respondents in the Originating Summons Suit being CSOS/5/2024 by an order of the Division Bench dated 9th June, 2026.

It is the case of the applicants that the plaintiffs in the Originating Summons Suit failed to carry out the amendment as a consequence whereof the applicants are compelled to apply for the addition to be incorporated in terms of the order dated 9th June, 2026.

On a perusal of the application it does not appear that the details and particulars of the 236 persons directed to be added as party respondents have been provided in a copy of the Originating Summons Suit and annexed to the application to enable the department to carry out such amendment.

In the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the applicants are granted liberty to file a supplementary affidavit annexing therein a copy of the Originating Summons Suit as it stands now and thereafter provide the particulars of the 236 persons in green ink in the cause title after the existing respondents. The particulars are directed to be shown in green ink as there is already an amendment by virtue of which respondents no. 3 to 112 have been added by dint of the order dated 14th July, 2026 passed in APOT/23/2026.

Let such supplementary affidavit be filed by 24th August, 2026 with a copy to the plaintiffs and the other respondents.

The plaintiffs will be entitled to use a sur-rejoinder, if so advised, by 31st August, 2026.

Let the application being GA/11/2026 appear in the list on 2nd September, 2026.

The plaintiffs in the Originating Summons Suit shall by course of

tomorrow (14-08-2026) serve an amended copy of the Originating Summons Suit to the learned advocate for the applicants, if not already served.

The added respondent nos.3 to 112 intend to waive formal service of the summons and file written statement.

In the foresaid facts and circumstances, it is recorded that the respondent nos.3 to 112 waive formal service of the summons as on date (13-08-2026). The said respondent nos.3 to 112 shall file their written statement(s) by 11th September, 2026.

The department shall accept the written statement to be filed by the respondent nos.3 to 112 if the same is in proper order and form and placed before the department for being filed within the extended period of time.

Immediately upon the written statement being filed, a copy of such written statement with legible annexures be supplied to the learned advocate for the plaintiffs and the respondent nos.1 and 2. The Originating Summons Suit is directed to go out of the list for the time being with liberty to mention.

This is an application by the plaintiffs in this Originating Summons Suit for extension of time for enabling the learned Joint Special Officers to complete the sale of the properties and assets of the Trust as permitted by a previous order and also to permit the learned Joint Special Officers to operate the bank account of Trust for defraying daily/regular expenses to be

incurred by the Joint Special Officers for the purpose of sale of the properties and assets of the Trust.

The plaintiffs file the original report of the Joint Special Officers dated 26th June, 2026. The original of the said report is taken on record. The photocopy of this report is annexed to this application which has been served on the respondent nos.3 to 112 as also the 236 persons who have been added as respondents by virtue of the order dated 9th June, 2026 passed by the Hon'ble Division Bench.

Since a copy of the report is already available with the respondents and the 236 persons who have been directed to be added, there is no further requirement of service of the said report. In the event the respondent nos.3 to 112 and the 236 persons intend to take inspection of the original report to compare the same with the copy annexed to the application it will be open for the said respondents and the 236 persons to approach the learned Registrar, Original Side of this Court for such inspection. The respondent nos.3 to 112 as also the 236 persons who have been directed to be added as party respondents object to the prayers made in this application and seek leave to file affidavit to deal with the same.

Let affidavit-in-opposition be filed by 24th August, 2026; reply, if any, thereto be filed by 31st August, 2026.

Let the application being GA/12/2026 appear in the list on 2nd September, 2026.
