The Court: This is an execution application filed by the judgment debtor arising out of a consent decree. The judgment debtor has only paid a total quantum covering more than one installment but less than the two installments as mentioned in **page 22** to the supporting affidavits.

The cause title shows that the judgment debtor is outside the territorial limit of this Court.

In view of the above, the judgment debtor shall file an affidavit of assets disclosing its assets both the immovable and movable properties including the bank accounts wherever they are lying. The affidavit of assets shall also disclose if anything is there within the State of West Bengal.
