The Court :- 1. Challenging the order issued under Section 148A(3) of the Income Tax Act, 1961 (hereinafter referred to as the said Act) for the assessment year 2021-22 dated 24th June, 2025 on the ground that the same has been issued beyond the scope of the notice issued under Section 148A(1) of the said Act dated 24th March, 2025, the instant writ petition has been filed.
