The Court : This is an application by the mother and natural guardian of a minor girl child seeking leave of the Court to permit sale of an immovable property belonging to the deceased husband and the father of the minor wherein the minor is said to have 1/6th share. It also appears that the immovable property situate at 152, Rabindra Sarani, Kolkata – 700 007 (hereinafter referred to as 'the said property') was jointly owned by Vinod Agarwal, the deceased father of the minor and Sunil Agarwal, the uncle of the minor. The property is undivided and as such before passing an order let a notice be issued on Sunil Agarwal to enable him to give his views regarding the proposed sale.

Let this matter appear on 16th September, 2026. Service as aforesaid be effected in the meantime.
