The Court :- The subject Will is dated 15th December, 2000 which is a registered Will. Out of the two attesting witnesses, one is Dr. S. K. Bhattacharya and the other one is Amitabha Sengupta. The petitioner says that Amitabha Sengupta has died. The notice sent to Dr. S. K. Bhattacharya has come back "Undelivered" due to insufficient address. In the Will the address of Dr. Bhattacharya is given as 76 Biren Roy Road (West), Kolkata 700061 with his registration no. 32609. It will not be impossible to know about the whereabouts of Dr. S. K. Bhattacharya, if necessary enquiry is made with the Indian Medical Association (in short IMA) since as a registered practitioner one has to be associated with Indian Medical Association. Before the Will is directed to be proved in solemn form by any attending witness, the petitioner

should make a last effort to find out Dr. S. K. Bhattacharya by enquiring with the Indian Medical Association.

The Registrar-in-Insolvency, Original Side of this Court is directed to communicate this order to the Indian Medical Association with a request to inform the registry as to the whereabouts of Dr. S. K. Bhattacharya.
