The Court: Mr. Bhattacharyya learned AAG appears for the alleged contemnor. He submits that the alleged contemnor is absolutely intended to carry out the Court's order in terms of Judgement dated February 27, 2024. However, for the same, the land of the petitioner is required to be demarcated by the BL & LRO, Kolkata at 24 Parganas South.

For this reasons, Mr. Bhattacharyya has sought for a direction upon the BL & LRO to take steps for demarcation of the plot of land owned by the petitioner.

The parties have already filed respective affidavits in the instant contempt application. However, it is found necessary that before taking up the contempt application for hearing on merits, the BL & LRO, Kolkata at 24 Parganas South, be directed to take immediate steps for demarcation of the petitioner's plot of land.

Let the compliance report in this regard be filed by the BL & LRO, Kolkata at 24 Parganas South in Court on the next date of hearing.

The exercise of demarcation of plot of land of the petitioner by the BL & LRO, shall be carried out in presence of the petitioner as well as a representative of the alleged contemnor, allowing them to take part in the process, by providing necessary input to the BL & LRO.

Let the matter be adjourned today and listed after four weeks.
