The Court: An affidavit has been filed by Mr. Bhattacharya on behalf of the alleged contemnors.

An inspection report containing three pages is also filed by the said alleged contemnors.

Let both the above documents be taken on record.

Mr. Roy for the petitioner seeks leave to take out an exception to the inspection report, as well as the affidavit so filed by the alleged contemnors. He submits that the person, namely, Tarak Singh, who was present at the time of inspection, bears no connection with the land in question as the same does not fall within his jurisdiction, he being a councillor of some other ward under Kolkata Municipal Corporation.

It is further submitted that at the premises no. 38A/51, Jyotish Roy Road, Kolkata-700053, a pond is mentioned in the said inspection report. According to the petitioner, that is also an erroneous statement insofar as the concerned land is mutated in the name of the petitioner, in the books of Kolkata Municipal Corporation itself.

Conceding to the request of Mr. Roy, it is directed that the petitioner may take out an exception to the inspection report submitted in Court today, as well as to the affidavit.

Let the exceptions, as above, be filed within two weeks.

Let this matter come up again for further consideration of the Court after three weeks.
