The Court :This is an application for grant of probate of the last Will and Testament dated December 21, 2012 left behind by the deceased above named.

The wife of the deceased died a little more than two years after the death of the testator. The death certificate of the wife forms annexure 'E' (at page 19) of the application for grant of probate.
