To Court : The learned advocate representing the decree holder submitted that the decree holder is not agreeable to the proposition of the matter to be sent for mediation.

The learned advocate representing the judgement debtor submitted the willingness on the part of the judgement debtor to pursue the process of mediation. However, since the decree holder are not inclined to be subjected to mediation, the order dated 29th August, 2025 which had been passed at the instance of the co-ordinate bench requesting the parties to seek instruction as to whether the matter could be sent to mediation, accordingly, could not be consensually complied with.
