The Court:- Learned counsel for the petitioner judgment-debtor in GA/4/2024 prays that he may be allowed to pay Rs.6,12,000/-, which is lying in the bank account no. 07921200000082 to the decree holder and he has prayed that after payment he may be allowed to operate his bank account.

Learned counsel appearing for the decree-holder has submitted that he has no objection if the amount of Rs.6,12,000/- is paid or remitted to him but he has serious objection against the other prayers made in GA/4/2024.

It appears from the record and from the submission of the learned counsel for the parties that more than Rs.86 lakhs have become dues and outstanding.

As such, the prayer of the judgment-debtor is allowed.

The amount of Rs.6,12,000/- lying in the bank account as aforesaid be remitted to the account of the decree-holder and the judgment-debtor is allowed to operate the relevant bank account only for two weeks.

However, until further order, the judgment-debtor cannot be arrested.

The judgment-debtor is directed to liquidate the balance amount as early as possible.

Manager, DCB Bank, Shakespeare Sarani Branch, is directed to remit the amount of Rs.6,12,000/- from the account of the judgment-debtor, Vijendra Kumar Goel, to the account of the decree-holder after being communicated by the learned counsel of the decree-holder.

List the matter on 9th May, 2024.
