The Court : Learned counsel for the award-holder seeks a direction for substituted service.

Affidavit of service filed in Court today be kept on record. It transpires from the said affidavit of service that it cannot be ruled out that the award-debtors are deliberately avoiding service.

Accordingly, the award-holder is directed to effect substituted service by publication in two daily newspapers having moderately good circulation in the area of the last-known address of the award-debtors, one of which shall be in English and the other in Bengali vernacular.

The matter shall next be listed in the monthly list of September, 2024 when a further affidavit of service shall be filed by the award-holder.
