The petitioner remains unrepresented. Although, this contempt application is appearing for the first time and there has been no direction for service of the application upon the alleged contemnor as yet, but the alleged contemnor is represented by Ms. Babita Das, learned advocate.

It is submitted on behalf of the alleged contemnor that a copy of the contempt application has been received by the alleged contemnor through the department on which the application has been served. It is further submitted on behalf of the alleged contemnor that the order under contempt has been complied with. The principal respondent in the writ petition wherefrom the order under contempt emanates was directed to hear out the application in accordance with law and in the light of the order dated 10th July,

2025, in the event the petitioner made a fresh and appropriate application leave for which was given also to the petitioner.

It is submitted by the alleged contemnor that in terms of the said order the application made by the petitioner has been disposed of after giving the petitioner a personal hearing. The reasoned order has also been communicated to the petitioner.

The alleged contemnor has filed an affidavit of compliance in the registry at Port Blair stating therein that the order under contempt has been complied with. The affidavit of compliance is, however, not on record.

Learned advocate for the alleged contemnor shall communicate this order to the petitioner and/or his advocate. The petitioner and/or his advocate shall also serve a copy of the contempt application upon the respondent and her advocate.

The registry at Port Blair is directed to send the affidavit of compliance which is said to have been filed by the alleged contemnor.
