1. Heard the submission of the petitioner. The subject matter of the challenge of the this writ petition is an order passed by the Secretary Revenue being appellant authority on 15.01.2026 whereby the appeal was rejected.
2. It is argued on behalf of the petitioner that in the report of the appellate forum arrived at such conclusion on the basis of a report of joint inspection. However, no such report was given to the present writ petitioner.
3. Primarily in the report it was mentioned that such inspection report was provided to the petitioner which has been denied by the petitioner.
4. The learned advocate representing the respondents Nos. 1,2,3,4 & 6 intended to file affidavit-in-opposition.
5. The learned advocate of the petitioner also prays for liberty to file the supplementary affidavit to annex some relevant documents which are necessary for the purpose of adjudication.

6. Liberty is given to the petitioner to file such supplementary affidavit and to serve the copy of the same to the respondents.

7. Respondents are directed to file the affidavit-in-opposition from the date of receiving of the supplementary affidavit. Affidavit-in-reply, if any, thereto be filed within a week thereafter.

8. Matter be placed before the next Circuit Bench.
