The challenge preferred in the writ petition is to the non-grant of similar benefits to the writ petitioners as other allegedly similarly placed persons, who have already been given benefits of 1/30th of the minimum of the relevant pay scale plus dearness allowance in terms of the earlier order of this Court.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondents disputes such contention and seeks some time to ascertain as to whether the petitioners are similarly placed as the other persons referred to.

Accordingly, the respondents are directed to file their affidavit-in-opposition to the writ petition within a fortnight from date. Reply thereto, if any, shall be filed within a week thereafter
