This application has been made by the mother of a minor girl, who was impregnated allegedly by the Child Conflict with Law (CCL) sometime in February, 2026, seeking termination of pregnancy.

The cause for concern in this matter is that the impregnated victim girl is merely 16 years of age and has a very low blood count, which may be a challenge to her health and mental well being if she gives birth to the child.

I have been informed by Mr. Rakesh Kumar, Learned Advocate appearing for the respondent nos. 2 and 3 that a Medical Board in consonance with Section 3, (2) (D) of the Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act, 1971 has already been constituted. However, it appears from the records and submissions made by the parties that the Medical board is yet to form any opinion regarding the termination of the victim girl's pregnancy.

Since the pregnancy is at an advanced stage (almost 28 weeks), the Medical Board which has been constituted is directed to convene at the earliest and take a reasoned decision in the matter. The Board will file a report by June 11, 2026 with this Hon'ble Court. The report shall bear the signature of all the members of the Board and their respective stamps. The report shall be filed in a sealed cover with the Registrar of the Circuit Bench of the High Court at Calcutta at Port Blair by the aforesaid date.

List this matter on June 12, 2026 under the heading 'For Orders' for further consideration.
