Mr. Hussain, learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner seeks leave to file a supplementary affidavit, bringing on record certain relevant documents which according to him have been missed in the writ application.

As prayed for, let such supplementary affidavit be filed within a week from date. A copy of the supplementary affidavit shall be served upon the learned Advocate appearing for the respondent.

Mr. Rakesh Kumar appearing for the respondents, on the other hand submits that he has a bulky record to go through and he would like to demonstrate that there has been no violation of natural justice in the present case.

In such view of the matter, let affidavit-in-opposition to the writ petition as well as the supplementary affidavit be filed within four weeks from the date of service of the copy of the supplementary affidavit.

Affidavit-in-reply thereto, if any, be filed within two weeks thereafter.

List this matter before the next Circuit Bench available immediately after expiry of the time fixed for exchange of affidavits. The point of maintainability of the writ petition is kept open.
