OFFICE REPORT

The matter above mentioned was listed before the Hon'ble Court on 05.09.2012 with an Office Report dated 04.09.2012, when the Court was pleased to pass the following Order:

*“Two weeks' time is allowed to the counsel for Union of India for filing vakalatnama and counter affidavit. Two weeks' thereafter is allowed for filing rejoinder affidavit, if any. List thereafter.”*

It is submitted that Mr. B.K. Prasad, Advocate has on 17.10.2012 filed counter affidavit alongwith vakalatnama/appearance on behalf of Respondent No. 2, viz., Union of India but not served the copy on Respondent No. 1 despite this Registry's letter dated 01.11.2012. Same has been included in the Paper Books.

It is further submitted that no rejoinder affidavit has been filed after filing counter affidavit on behalf of Respondent No. 2, so far. However, rejoinder affidavit to the brief response of Respondent No. 1 has been filed by Counsel for the Petitioner on 27.06.2012 and the same has been included in the Paper Books.

Service of show cause notice is complete.

Thereafter, the matter above mentioned was lastly listed before the Hon'ble Court on 30.07.2014 with an Office Report dated 25.07.2014, when the Court was pleased to pass the following Order:

*“List the matter for hearing on a non-miscellaneous day.”*

It is lastly submitted that no further documents have been filed by any of the parties.
