These petitions are directed against judgment dated 24.11.2008 of the learned Single Judge of the Karnataka High Court whereby he dismissed the appeal filed by the petitioners under Section 173(1) of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and allowed the one filed by the Insurance Company and declared that the latter is not liable to pay compensation in terms of the award passed by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal.
