UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

Heard Mr. Mehta, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioners. He points out that respondent Nos.2 to 8 are eligible for pension under the Pension Scheme of the first petitioner Bank framed in 2010 and they are not eligible under the 1995 Scheme. They are being paid pension as per 2010 Pension Scheme. He further points out that as far as respondent Nos. 9 and 10 are concerned they have not applied under 2010 Pension Scheme and as far as respondent No.1 is concerned, he is now represented through his widow and she has not taken steps under the 2010 Pension Scheme. Under the circumstances, issue notice to the respondents returnable in six weeks.

In the meanwhile and until further orders, the operation of the impugned judgment will remain stayed.
