O R D E R

The petitioner – wife has filed this Transfer Petition seeking transfer of **FCOP No. 1346 OF 2023** titled as “**Maale Thimma Dasu Vs. Matta Summathi**” from the Family Court at R. R. District, L.B. Nagar, Telangana to III Additional District Court, Kurnool at Nandyal, Andhra Pradesh.

Despite service of notice, no one has entered appearance on behalf of the respondent.

The petitioner-wife contends that the distance between L.B. Nagar, Telangana and Nandyal, Andhra Pradesh is quite far and there would be great inconvenience for her to attend the proceedings at L.B. Nagar, Telangana.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the averments made in the Transfer Petition, in our view, it would be inconvenient to the petitioner (wife), who is staying in Nandyal Dist, Andhra Pradesh to attend the proceedings at L. B. Nagar, Telangana.

In view of the foregoing and having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, we deem it appropriate to allow this

transfer petition. Accordingly, **FCOP No. 1346 OF 2023** titled as “**Maale Thimma Dasu Vs. Matta Summathi**” is ordered to be transferred from the Family Court at R. R. District, L.B. Nagar, Telangana to Principal District and Sessions Judge, Kurnool, Andhra Pradesh, who may assign the case to a competent Court.

Needless to observe that the transferee court may allow the presence of the respondent (husband) on virtual platform without insisting for his presence on every date until required necessarily.

Let the records of the case be transferred to the transferee court without delay and an intimation be sent to both the courts through e-mail for compliance.

The Transfer Petition is, accordingly, allowed.
