O R D E R

Heard the learned Senior counsel appearing for the petitioner
and the learned Senior counsel appearing for the complainant.
Having regard to the facts and circumstances of this case, we
are inclined to grant pre-arrest bail to the petitioner and in the
event of his arrest, he shall be released on bail upon furnishing
personal bond in the sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five
Thousand only) along with two sureties of Rs.10,000/- each to the
satisfaction of the concerned Investigating Officer/Station House

Officer on the following terms and conditions:-

(i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for
interrogation by a Police Officer as and when required and
cooperate with the investigation without fail.

(ii) that the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly
make any inducement, threat or promise to any person
acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade
him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or any Police
Officer;

(iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without
previous permission of the Court.

In case of any breach of the conditions, this Court, on being
informed thereof, would, if inclined, initiate suo motu steps for
cancellation of the anticipatory bail, which is hereby granted.

The Special Leave Petition is disposed of in the afore-stated
terms.

Consequent upon the disposal of the Special Leave Petition,
pending applications filed in the matter are also disposed of.
