OFFICE REPORT

The matter above-mentioned was listed before the Hon'ble Court on 25th July, 2014, when the Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

Mr. Vikas Singh, learned senior counsel for the petitioners, submits that in Federal Bank Ltd. & Others Vs. State of Kerala & Others, (2007) 4 SCC 188, this Court was concerned with the definition of 'Dealer' in Kerala General Sales Tax Act, 1963, as amended by Kerala Finance Act, 1998. Learned senior counsel further submits that the definition of 'Dealer' in Odisha Value Added Tax Act, 2004 is significantly different.

Issue notice returnable in ten weeks.

Dasti, in addition to the ordinary process, is permitted.

In the meanwhile, no coercive process shall be taken against the petitioners for recovery of the demand amount.

Accordingly, show cause notice returnable on 13th October, 2014 was issued to all the four respondents through Registered A.D. Post on 27th August, 2014. Dasti notice was also issued to the counsel for the petitioners for effecting service on the respondents. Ms. Kirti R. Mishra, Advocate has on 28th August, 2014 filed Vakalatnama/Appearance on behalf of all the four respondents but has not filed Counter Affidavit so far.

The matter is listed before the Hon'ble Court with this office report.
