J U D G M E N T

1. Leave granted.
2. The present appeal is directed against the impugned order dated 20.12.2024 passed by the High Court of Andhra Pradesh at Amaravati in Criminal Petition No.5152 of 2024, whereby the High Court has dismissed the application seeking anticipatory bail

of the appellants in connection with FIR/Crime No.138 of 2024 dated 18.06.2024 registered with Police Station Tiruchanur, District Tirupathi for the offences under Sections 376, 109 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

4. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the appellants that they are the parents of the accused. He also submitted that both the appellants have cooperated with the Investigating Officer.

5. The said submissions are not disputed by the learned counsel for the respondent No.1 - State.

6. Hence, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the appeal is accepted.

7. Hence, it is directed that in the event of arrest of the appellants in connection with FIR/Crime No.138 of 2024 dated 18.06.2024 registered with Police Station Tiruchanur, District Tirupathi,

they shall be released on bail on the terms and conditions that may be imposed by the Trial Court.

8. It goes without saying that any breach of the conditions that may be imposed by the Trial Court for releasing them on bail, shall entail cancellation of the bail.

9. Subject to the afore-stated, the present appeal is allowed.

10. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
