The Criminal Miscellaneous Petition Nos. 2893-2894/2014 (applications for exemption from surrendering) were listed before the Hon'ble Judge in Chambers on 10.02.2014 when His lordship was pleased to pass the following order:

"The prayer for exemption from surrendering is rejected. However, the petitioner is granted six weeks' time to surrender and file proof thereof.

Registry shall list the matter before the appropriate Bench after certificate of proof of surrender is filed ."

It is submitted that Dr. Kailash Chand, Advocate has on 26.03.2014 filed proof of surrender of the petitioner. Copy of the same is being circulated herewith for kind perusal of the Hon'ble Court.

It is submitted that there is delay of 2 days in filing proof of surrender and the counsel has not filed application for condonation of delay in filing the same.

It is further submitted that Crl. Appeal No. 1762/2009 arising out of Special Leave Petition (Crl.) No.6153 of 2009 filed against Order dated 20.03.2009 in Crl. Appeal No. 413/1993 as referred to on Annexure P-4 was listed before Hon'ble Court on 11.09.2009 when the Court was pleased to grant leave in the matter and also released the appellant on bail. (Copy of the Record of Proceedings dated 11.09.2009 is being circulated herewith for the kind perusal of the Hon'ble Court.) Crl. Appeal No. 1762/2009 is a ready matter and is pending for hearing before this Hon'ble Court.

The matters above mentioned are therefore listed before the Hon'ble Court with this office report.
