**OFFICE REPORT ON DEFAULT**

The matter above-mentioned was listed before the Hon'ble Judge in Chambers on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2014, when the Court was pleased to pass the following Order:

**“An application was filed by the petitioner through Mr. B.K. Prasad, learned advocate, without any Vakalatnama/appearance, for deletion of Respondent No.4 from the array of parties. Although time was granted earlier for filing Vakalatnama, but till date nothing has been done. Hence, the application stands rejected.**

**The defects as pointed out, in the substitution petition, to bring the Lrs. of deceased respondent No.3 have not been cured. However, as prayed, two weeks' more time is allowed to do the needful.”**

It is submitted that the Counsel for the petitioner has not cured the defects of application for substitution so far and the time has been expired on 14.4.2014 for that purpose.

It is submitted that the application for deletion the name of Respondent No. 4 from the array of parties has been rejected vide this Hon'ble Court's order dated 31.3.2014 and counsel for the petitioner has not taken any steps for completion of service upon unserved respondent No. 4 so far.

The default on the part of counsel for petitioner is listed before the Hon'ble Judge in Chambers with this office report.
