O R D E R

Permission to file the special leave petition is granted.

We have heard learned counsel for the petitioner at length.

Considering the facts and circumstances, we are not inclined to interfere in the matter. However, since the record

indicates that dispute between the parties has been referred to mediation by an order passed by the High Court in a writ petition between the parties. It is desirable that the mediation proceedings are concluded as expeditiously as possible and should not be delayed at the instance of the either of the parties.

In such circumstances, we provide that both the parties shall extend their full co-operation in the disposal of the mediation proceedings expeditiously and the same shall be concluded within a period of six weeks from today. In case, there is default on the part of the accused to delay the execution proceedings, it is left open to the petitioner to make an application seeking recall of this order.

With the aforesaid observations, the Special Leave Petition(s) is/are dismissed.
