Service is deemed to be complete on respondent nos.3 and 5.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that as per office report, respondent no.7 is common respondent in SLP(C) No.22562/2018 and SLP(C) No. 14626/2019. Respondent no.7 in SLP(C) No.22562/2018 has been duly served, accordingly office report indicates that service of notice may be deemed to be complete against respondent no.7. However, as per record, respondent no.7 in SLP(C) No.22562/2018, though served but none has entered appearance till date. Therefore, respondent no.7 in SLP(C) No. 14626/2019 cannot be deemed to be served with notice in the said petition. Office report indicating that service is deemed to be complete against the said respondent is, thus, incorrect.

As per office report ld. Counsel for the petitioner has not taken fresh steps in respect of respondent no.7 despite last opportunity having been granted. However, ld.
