Ld. Counsel for the petitioner to take fresh steps for effecting service on respondent Nos.1, 3, 5 and 7 within two weeks.

Service is complete on respondent Nos.2, 4 and 6 but none has entered appearance.

None appeared for respondent Nos.1 to 5 when called. The record shows that notice was served on respondent Nos.1 to 5 on or about 27.8.2018 and vakalatnama on behalf of the said respondents has been filed on 1.10.2019, however, counter

affidavit has not been filed till today. There is neither written application for extension of time to file pleadings in terms of Order V Rule 1(22), Supreme Court Rules, 2013 nor is there oral request to that effect. It appears that the respondents are not interested in filing counter affidavit and, therefore, opportunity to file counter affidavit stands declined.

Service is complete on respondent Nos.6 and 7 but none has entered appearance.

Spare copy has not been filed in respect of respondent No.8 (Impleaded party). Ld. Counsel for the petitioner seeks two weeks' more time to file spare copy. Last chance is granted to file spare copy within two weeks. If spare copy is not filed within two weeks, Registry to process the matter for listing before the Hon'ble Judge in Chamber for orders. If spare copy is filed within two weeks, be processed as per rules and the matter be listed before this Court again on 29.1.2020.
