O R D E R

SLP(C) D.NO. 3447/2025

The matter is already directed to be listed before the Hon'ble Court vide this Court's order dated 22.09.2025.

It is submitted on behalf caveator/respondent no.7 that he would file counter affiavit during the course of day. Let the same be filed.

Learned counsel for respondent nos. 1 to 6 seeks more time to file counter affidavit. Let the same be filed in the meantime.

SLP(C) D.NO. 59220/2024

Four weeks' time, as last opportunity, is granted to respondent nos. 1 to 22 to file counter affidavit.

Since respondent no.17 has entered appearance, application for substituted service with regard to respondent no.17 filed by learned counsel for the petitioner becomes infructuous.

After expiry of four weeks, list the matter before the Hon'ble Court.

**SLP(C) D.NO. 59737/2024**
