It is further submitted that for non-filing of affidavit of dasti service upon respondent Nos. 1 and 2, the matter above-mentioned was listed before the Court of Registrar on various dates and lastly listed before the Court of Registrar on 23rd September, 2016 when the following Order was passed:-

Registrar has also not filed vakalatnama/appearance and counter-affidavit so far.
