O R D E R

1. Leave granted.
2. Heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the relevant material.
3. We find no infirmity in the order of the High Court except that the compensation package that has to be worked out in terms of paragraph 21 of the impugned judgment of the High Court gives rise to a situation where all the workmen (13 in number) would be entitled to Rs.1.5 to 2.0 lakhs.
4. Having regard to the facts of the case, the period of service rendered and also the fact that the concerned workmen have become over-aged, we are of the view that the compensation package should be enhanced to an

amount of Rs.4,00,000/- (Rupees four lakhs only) for each of the workmen. We order accordingly.

5. We further direct that the payment, as ordered above, be made to the concerned workmen within a period of three months.

6. With the aforesaid modification in the order of the High Court the appeals are disposed of.
