UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following

O R D E R

IA No.50392/2026 SLP (Crl.) No.20385/2025:

1. An application is filed for grant of interim suspension of sentence for a period of four weeks on the ground of demise of applicant's father.
2. The applicant came to be tried and convicted for the offence punishable under Sections 302, 323, 341 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 by the Sessions Court on 23/28.08.2019 and unsuccessfully challenged the same in Criminal Appeal No.1259/2018 which came to be dismissed on 23.12.2022.
3. Having heard the learned counsels appearing for the parties, we notice that during the

pendency of the criminal appeal before the High Court, the sentence was not suspended. However, in the light of the subsequent event namely, the father of the applicant having expired on 10.02.2026 and applicant being the son, we are of the considered view that he would be entitled for being released on interim bail for a period of four weeks to enable him to perform obsequies ceremonies. Hence, the sentence imposed by the learned Sessions Judge on 23/28.08.2019 as affirmed under the impugned order 23.12.2022 stands suspended and applicant is ordered to be enlarged on bail for a period of four (4) weeks on such terms and conditions as the jurisdictional Sessions Court may impose. Applicant is ordered to be released on bail for a period of four (4) weeks only and on completion of four weeks, he shall surrender before the Jail Authorities from whose custody he is being released. It is also made clear that the applicant shall mark his attendance before the jurisdictional police weekly twice

between 10:00 am and 01:00 pm till the date of
surrender. Interlocutory application is
accordingly allowed in part.
